MINUTES

The meeting was chaired by Tony Troughton.

1. Minutes of previous meeting (12th April 2010)

The minutes were accepted as being accurate.

2. Burglary

4 Burglaries from dwellings which is up 3 for this time last year. Burglary from cars is up 12% across the whole area. People are being encouraged not to leave items of value on display in cars.

3. Anti Social Driving

Tony Troughton spoke about the new speed limit on Straight Road and how effective the speed indicator devices are. Tony also spoke about the forthcoming plans for the junction of Church Road and Straight Road. Concerns were raised about the number of vehicles with unrestrained children on board during the school runs. Claire Allison would write to the parents to warn them of the dangers. Tony Troughton also talked about our concerns with the Burfield Road/Crimp Hill junction where the children cross for school. The RBWM have agreed to install flashing signs to warn of the existence of a school crossing.

4. Anti Social behaviour

We were informed that 3 ABC's (Antisocial Behaviour Contracts) had been issued with 3 more being considered. Local concerns about the build up of young people at the shops in St Lukes Shopping area especially at the back of the Coop and also at the recreation ground. There has been a 31% drop in anti social behaviour compared to last year.

5. AOB

The contract for the Police Post should be in place shortly and then tenders will go out. Pete Dalton has confirmed that the Police Caravan will be at this years carnival as in previous years. Andy Aldridge confirmed that two dog walkers had been issued fixed penalty notices for allowing their dogs to foul and not cleaning it up. St Peters School has their open day on 4th July from 11am until 2pm. Gemma Stevenson has left her job and will no longer attending our meeting and Claire Allison's job is finishing and this was her last meeting. The meeting wished her well for the future and thanked her for her invaluable input and support
