MINUTES

The meeting was chaired by Tony Troughton.

1. Minutes of previous meeting (2nd March 2010)

The minutes were accepted as being accurate.

2. Burglary

1 arrested for 3 burglaries in the area, actually came from Coventry. Burglaries to dwellings were up two on last year but burglaries to outbuildings were down on last year.

3. Anti Social Driving

Steve Parker said that there had been a drink driver caught in Old Windsor and numerous vehicles seized for no road tax. A multi agency operation was in progress at Runnymede involving officers from Windsor and from Surrey. The officers present stated that they were in favour of a 30mph speed limit on the Straight Road which starts on the 22nd of April. We are all looking to see how well the drivers are informed of the change.

4. Anti Social behaviour

Steve Parker stated that officers were regularly visiting the recreation ground and know the core of the troublemakers. Nearly all of these individuals are not from Old Windsor. Tony Troughton reported that large quantities of broken glass were found in the mornings on the recreation ground that causes a very dangerous hazard to the public and the dogs that are walked there. An individual who has been found to be buying alcohol for the under aged has been banned from several shops. Antisocial Behaviour Contracts (ABC's) have been issued to about six individuals and they have been banned from some shops as well. Steve Parker stated that the Police are enforcing the alcohol bans in place in Old Windsor and trying to introduce late night patrols. Antisocial behaviour reports are down from 32 last year to 5 this year. Andy Aldridge reported that the recent graffiti damage cost £1,000 to put right.

5. AOB

Steve Parker said that he would follow up on the Police Post. Steve Parker also reported that John Devlin, our PCSO, had been replaced by Tom Druce who is from Windsor and very experienced. He will attend our next meeting. There

should also be another PCSO coming to Old Windsor very soon. Steve Parker also informed us that he will be moving on in June and he hoped to bring his replacement to our next meeting. Tony Troughton proposed our thanks to John Devlin for all he has done in Old Windsor.
