1. Minutes of previous meeting (5th January 2009)

2. The proposed Police Post

The Chairman reported that the process for approval of the new Police Post project has now been clarified by TVP but he was dismayed by the length of time it was likely to take.

3. Alcohol Ban

Although it is impossible to give an absolute assurance the Police are convinced that the main problem has been resolved but asked that villagers remain vigilant and report any suspicious activities.
