1. Minutes of previous meeting (4th August 2008)

2. Action points.

No further news about the proposed Police post which is awaiting specification, and agreement from the TVP Authority Board. The Chairman agreed to contact the TVP Property services department again to enquire about progress.

3. Alcohol Ban

Esther Deacon reported that proposals for extensions to the Borough Alcohol free zones would be presented to Cabinet on October 23rd. If agreed formal consultation would follow and notices published in the local press by November 27th. The outcome of the consultation would then be reported back to Cabinet and if approved would be implemented by April 2009.

The Chairman reported back regarding recent correspondence with the local MP, Mr Adam Afryie, regarding Police staffing levels. A question has also been tabled for the Chief Constable who will be attending the Borough Crime and Disorder Forum later in the month.

8. Anti Social Behaviour.

An increase in anti social behaviour was noted coincident with the school summer holidays.

It was noted with great regret that Mrs Marian Troughton has decided to step down as Village Neighbourhood Watch Coordinator following a campaign of abusive e-mails from one village resident.
