**1. Minutes of previous meeting (3<sup>rd</sup> November 2008)**

Were accepted as an accurate record.

**2. The proposed Police Post**

TVP Property Services department estimates for building work and fit out have now been received together with a suggested division of costs. Clarification of the requirements has also been received and will be considered by the Parish Council on December 10<sup>th</sup> 2008.

Inspector Dalton confirmed that he fully supported the proposal to site a Police post in the village.

**7. Parking**

Continuing activity by Borough Parking Attendants in the village was noted. Inspector Dalton confirmed that his officers would continue to deal with obstruction of pavements and dropped kerbs.

**8. Anti Social Behaviour**

Esther Deacon reported that for quarter 2 (July to September 2008) there were 36 incidents of ASB in Old Windsor. (7.5 incidents per 1000 population). In the same period in 2007 there were 65 incidents so the latest figures amount to a 45% reduction. By comparison there were 267 incidents in Windsor Town Centre, 172 in Dedworth, Clewer and Oakley Green, 159 in Ascot, Sunningdale and Sunninghill. The cumulative figure from April to October is 109 incidents in Old Windsor, a reduction of 24.8% compared to the same period in 2007. These figures are taken from the Community Nuisance and Disorder Information System (CADIS) and are based on Police and Borough data.
