The Lead Member sent his report to members. Members deplored the fact that RBWM charge schools for the provision of salt bins and it was proposed by Cllr. Beer and seconded by Cllr. Mynott that the council write to RBWM expressing their concerns. All members were in favour. Old Windsor received six salt bins and they are all in situ. Members requested that the Lead Member attend the forthcoming Carnival Committee meeting to discuss plans for next years carnival and the change of access for John Walls Funfair. Proposed by Cllr. Dawson, seconded by Cllr. Andrews and all members in favour except one abstention. Three tenders have been returned so far for the Community Hub project and they will be evaluated. Future plans for a historical monument were discussed.
