

# **OLD WINDSOR COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP**

## **Board Meeting on Monday, 8th June 2009 Old Chapel Meeting Room**

### **Action Points & Decisions**

**Present:** Tony Troughton in the Chair, Duncan Pollock, John Lee, Steve Pilgrim, Dave Pinkstone and Christine Harris

- 1. Apologies for absence:** Steve Winton and Lynne Jones
- 2.** Tony Troughton advised that we should not continue to try to deal with the Partnerships Manager at RBWM but instead should deal with the CCB who have proved to be more helpful in the past.
- 3.** Duncan Pollock reported that following his letter to the Chairman of the Parish Council he had been advised that the request for funds towards the cost of the Village Name Signs had had a favourable response. It was likely that we would have a confirmation from the Parish Council after their next meeting.
- 4.** Christine Harris reported that she had had a good response from Winkfield Parish Church and it looked likely that we would be able to use the image of Edward the Confessor in one of their windows. The matter was to be discussed by their Parochial Council and we would be advised by the Church Warden in due course.
- 5.** Tony Troughton advised that we should budget for a cost of £K7 for the name signs and Dave Pinkstone felt that if we could not raise the total cost in the near future we could plan to install the signs in 2010 when the Old Windsor Carnival reaches its 50th Year.
- 6.** Tony Troughton reported on the work that was going on to provide better facilities for the village Youth Club in the face of very little support from the Borough Council.
- 7.** Tony Troughton advised that he would be standing down from the Chair in the near future as he had taken over the Chair of the Parish Council and he felt that he should not do both jobs concurrently. He would however wish to remain on the Partnership Board.
